# Country of Origin Labelling

As you will have heard, later this year, all retailers will be required to display the country of origin on some foods.

In order to get ready for this change, Foodstuffs and GS1 have been readying our article data systems to handle this change correctly.

If your product comes from a single country, please make sure that this is reflected in the "Country of origin" field for each product.

If your product might come from more than one country, or is fish caught in the high seas, use the Country of Origin statement to convey the details. This should mirror the text on your packaging, and be specific about the countries or oceans where the product is sourced.

Please note that the regulations affect minimally processed, single ingredient fresh or thawed fruit, vegetables, fish, meat (including cured pork products), and poultry.

## Priced Packing Slips

We've had a few queries from stores about stock coming in without a valid priced packing slip.

We realise that priced packing slips are an unusual requirement in New Zealand's business milieu, but they are required due to Foodstuffs' unusual business structure. Put simply, you invoice Foodstuffs, but deliver to the store. Since you can't invoice two parties for the same goods and the store needs the delivery price, then you need to send a priced packing slip with the goods.
